## What's happened?

Winter is upon us! Camp Tulakadik is a winter wonderland and the snow keeps coming. The fall of 2007 brought some time to plan for the upcoming winter and summer events. Our winter brochures have been sent out, and our website has been updated with all of the current information on upcoming events, including some dates for summer events such as Camp Tulakadik Sunday being held on June 8th this year.

We have two new and exciting building projects coming up in the spring. In recent years there have been several new cabins built here at the camp that are fully winterized and have room for a washroom in each. We are making the move to place washrooms in 4 of our cabins this spring that will be operational year round. This will be great for winter camps and retreats. No more running to the washroom building in the middle of the night! This project is a continued effort to improve and modernize our great facilities.

The second project we have this spring is to construct a 30 foot climbing and rappelling tower. The wall will have two climbing surfaces on which campers can ascend on artificial rock holds, and one surface for descending on a rope. This activity is an excellent self-confidence builder and will bring a real sense of accomplishment to each camper, no matter how high they climb. The wall is another great tool to build relationships with campers and share the gospel with them. Over the past two years our churches have helped to bring two great new programs to Camp Tulakadik - a ropes challenge course, and a kayaking program. The wall project is continued effort to improve the quality of our programs.

2007 was an unprecedented year of growth at Camp Tulakadik. 64 campers made decisions for Christ, we saw over a 22% increase in camper registrations and reached an all-time high for camper numbers. Our family camp was full, our first pond hockey tournament had 17 teams compete, we introduced a new kayaking program, a new chiefs cabin was built and set in place by six association churches, there were 550 people at Camp Tulakadik Sunday, individual donations were up by 236%, the list goes on and on. We look forward to another great year in 2008. God is good.
